# OPERATIONAL RECOMMENDATIONS

The delivered products, in particular wooden and wood-based elements, are intended for use in dry and closed rooms, protected against atmospheric influences at a temperature of  $18^{\circ}$  C to  $23^{\circ}$  C and a relative humidity in the range of 40% to 60%. The delivered products cannot be exposed to direct influence of heat sources (distance from heat sources is not less than 1m).

### WOOD

This material is characterized by various properties, therefore there may be differences in the color shades of individual product elements seen from different angles at different light intensities. The occurrence of such a difference cannot be the basis for a complaint.

In addition, wood as a natural product may have: differences in the arrangement of rings, in shades of colors on individual elements and subassemblies, moreover, natural inserts such as: streaks, dots, knots, etc. This does not change the quality of the product, but even emphasizes its natural origin. Such features are not grounds for complaint.

Surfaces made of these materials should be cleaned with a soft, dry or slightly damp cloth and then wiped dry. Do not use any chemical cleaning agents. The manufacturer will not accept claims for damages resulting from their use.

### **FABRIC**

Regular cleaning of the fabric is important to keep the upholstery in top condition and extend its life. Dust and dirt damage the fabric and reduce its fireproof properties. Upholstery should be vacuumed frequently, preferably weekly, to remove grease-free stains, rub it carefully with a cloth or sponge squeezed in soapy water or water with a little washing-up liquid. Washing with soap consists of 1/4 servings of soap flakes to 1 liter of hot water. Allow the solution to cool down before use. Washing with washing-up liquid: a maximum of 1 teaspoon of washing-up liquid in 1 liter of water. For a concentrated liquid solution, use a few drops per liter of water. Then wipe the surface with clean warm water.

Warning! Do not rub the material hard as this can fade the color or potentially damage the fiber. Care should be taken when using solvents as they can dissolve upholstery materials under the fabric

## **VARNISHED COATINGS**

For cleaning varnished and galvanized surfaces, products intended for cleaning such surfaces are recommended, which do not contain abrasive and chemically aggressive agents causing damage to the coatings.

## **PLASTIC ELEMENTS**

To clean plastic parts, use generally available, non-scratch cleaning agents intended for cleaning plastic.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**
